

CRITICAL INCIDENT FIELDS

ESO Fire's Critical Incident fields give you the insight to help identify, intervene, and prevent symptoms and behaviors of PTSD from occurring. Two small fields could impact lives in a big way.

TRACK LOCATIONS

Understand where and when critical incidents are occurring in your response area, giving you the ability to proactively plan for these events and recognize where you need to focus your Community Risk Reduction efforts.

DOCUMENT CUMULATIVE EXPOSURES

For some, it may not be the severity of a critical incident that affects them; experiencing cumulative critical incidents can be just as damaging to stress levels. Identify firefighters or paramedics who have had these exposures to prioritize and assess their mental health.

ASK FOR HELP

Everyone has their own coping methods and some may struggle more than others during this process, yet they may feel uncomfortable reaching out for help. A simple "yes" selection on the Critical Incident identifier can provide firefighters with a loud, yet silent, way of seeking assistance.

ENABLE PEER SUPPORT TEAMS

Ensure firefighters are receiving the help and support they need by documenting if, and when, critical incident teams or peer support teams have been deployed and if any action has been taken. Obtain further insight by tracking the number of times these teams have been deployed to identify the need for larger or additional teams.

CREATE A SUPPORTIVE CULTURE

Show your crews that it is safe and acceptable to ask for help when they are struggling to cope. Creating a supportive and nonjudgmental culture provides firefighters and paramedics the validity and ability to reach out for help when they need it. Lives may be saved.
