Keep Crew Safety a Priority

Using the time-clock function, you can create daily check-in's by enabling a pre-shift screening that tracks symptoms and interactions indicative of COVID-19.

Manage Quarantine Scheduling

Easily flag employees as quarantined and prompt removal from the schedule. You can choose the number of days for your quarantine period to reflect your agency's protocols and then re-add employees back into the system when it's time to return to the station.

Enable COVID-19 Leave Policies

Stay on top of policy changes and make sure your agency is compliant with local, state and national rules. As changes occur you can update them for your own department by using the custom earning codes feature. For example, to ensure compliance with the recently enacted Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) simply add a new code to your custom earning codes list and you'll be set to provide additional leave as regulate.
